The National Archives of Australia will host the CAPO 27 art exhibition and auction party on 27 November. Live performances from Cora James and John Hill, as well as a feature spot from last year's Capital Insurance Brokers Emerging Artists Award winner Fenella Edwards will accompany the silent and live art auctions. The exclusive 2010 edition of CAPO's gorgeous auction catalogue will be provided to ticket holders and announcement of CAPO grant awards for 2010 will be a highlight of the evening.

Tickets for the CAPO 27 are available now. The early bird price is available until 1 November.

The 2010 CAPO Grant Round closes on 22 October. The Grants to be awarded on the evening of November 27 will include the CAPO Fellowship, the Reading Room CAPO London Exhibition Award, the Singapore Airlines Travelling Grant, the Eckersley's Materials Grant, the Capital Insurance Brokers Emerging Artist Grant, the Sage Legal Services Grant, the Workplace Research Associates Grant and the Rosalie Gascoigne Memorial Award (sponsored by Community CPS Credit Union)

CAPO is a volunteer non-profit organisation that has supported the ACT region's artists for 27 years.
